Regulation

INTERNATIONAL YOUTH INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP IN NOVUSS 2024

Goals and tasks

Goal - promote Novuss sports

Task - Find out the best players in Novuss among young people.

Give young Novuss players the motivation to develop their personal talent.

Place and time

The championship will take place on June 15, 2024, in Spunciems, Mazā Spuņciema iela 2, at Spunciems sports hall.

Start of the competition **10:00** am. Registration till **9: 30** am.

Management

The competition is organized by the presidium of the Latvian Novuss Federation and is led by the chief judge appointed by this presidium, Ainārs Pēčs (national category, Vaidava).

Participants

Competitions (girls and boys compete separately) take place in two age groups:

- Group 1 cadets (born in 2011 and younger);
- Group 2 youngsters (born 2007-2010).

Membership of the age group shall be determined by the year of birth, regardless of the date of birth.

Only LNF-labeled Novuss puck are allowed in the championship.

Participants are allowed to join the game if they have followed Novu's game Rule section 3 "Participant outfit," especially for shoes (only with clean, tidy swap sports shoes are allowed to compete).

Participants have to use their own inventory, Novuss cues and pucks.

Changing the puck and cue while playing is not allowed if they are not damaged.

Photography and filming can take place during the competition, with footage posted to the media.

Determination of winners

The competition takes place according to regulations approved by the Novuss Federation of Latvia. For cadets and youngsters, the game will consist of 4 sets. For the win (3-0, 3-1) - two points, for the draw (2-2) - one point, for the loss (0-3, 1-3) - zero points.

The order of competition will be determined by the table of judges depending on the number of participants present (time limit for all games may be used if necessary). The Member with the highest total score wins. In the case of an equal score, when played by a "round robin":

- After head to head games;
- After head to head game set ratio
- Over all game set ratios
- By Berger's coefficient.

When playing by Swiss system:

- By the Buchholz coefficient (all opponent point sums);
- By the incomplete Buchholz coefficient (all opponent point sums, minus smallest and biggest point sum)
- By points scored in the last 2 rounds, 3 rounds, etc.

Terms of enrolment

All expenses related to the arrival and residence of participants at place of competition shall be covered by the commanding organisation of participants or the participants themselves.

Awarding

First three place winners in each group will be awarded with diplomas and medals. All participants in the competition will receive memorable souvenirs.

Any legal or individual person may award contestants with their own prizes.

Application of competition

Applications shall be sent collectively or by the participants themselves. The application must state the name, birth details, county and the applicant's telephone number.
